- Substantially Complete Construction by late 2012



What is the MLK-MACC?

The Multi-Service Ambulatory Care Center:

- Provides walk-in outpatient services through:
 - Urgent Care Center treats non-life threatening issues such as fevers, colds and sprains.
 - Outpatient Clinics provide multi-specialty services for HIV/Aids, cardiology, dermatology, dentistry, geriatrics, neurology, orthopedic and physical therapy.
- NEW MACC will provide expanded outpatient services and efficient green space with infrastructure upgrades

What is the South Health Center?

- Provides services including sexually transmitted diseases, tuberculosis, and communicable disease immunizations
- Expansion will meet growing demand for services in South LA

What is the Hubert Humphrey Comprehensive Health Center?

- Provides major primary, specialty and ancillary services such as diabetes management, women's health, pediatrics and a screening clinic.
