SUPERVISOR RIDLEY-THOMAS APPLAUDS BOARD'S ADOPTION OF PLAN TO IMPROVE ALONDRA PARK POOL/WATER PLAY/SKATE PARK PROJECT IN UNINCORPORATED AREA OF SECOND DISTRICT

LOS ANGELES – The Board of Supervisors today adopted plans for construction of the Alondra Park Pool/Water Play/Skate Park Project in the Second District.

The project will replace the existing facilities with a new 25-by-25-meter pool, a 6,000-square-foot pool house and recreation building, a 3,000-square-foot water play area, a 14,000-square-foot skateboard park, new restroom building, picnic shelter, and various other improvements.

The project will include the Local Worker Program, which increases participation of employment for qualified local residents who live within a 15-mile radius of Alondra Park. The program was part of the County's Department of Public Works procurement process, authorized by the Board of Supervisors in December, 2009.

The project supports the Countywide Strategic goals by enriching lives through integrated cost-effective and client centered supportive services and enriching the lives of County residents and visitors by providing access to recreational facilities with quality regional open space, recreational, and public works infrastructure to diverse unincorporated communities.
