Environmental Impact Analysis for MLK MACC Replacement Project

On September 8, the Board of Supervisors (the Board) instructed the Chief Executive Office and the Director of the Department of Public Works (DPW) to provide a report on actions the Board of Supervisors must take to ensure that the design of the new Martin Luther King, Jr., Multi-service Ambulatory Care Center (MACC) is completed in time for the County to fully qualify for American Reinvestment and Recovery Act Funds (ARRA) to fund project construction. ARRA bonds must be issued no later than December 31, 2010. Based on the analysis performed by DPW, the Board must immediately begin the environmental impact analysis for the Martin Luther King, Jr. MACC Replacement Project to ensure timely issuance of the bonds.

I THEREFORE MOVE THAT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

Instruct the Chief Executive Office (CEO) to immediately proceed with the development of an Environmental Impact Report for the Martin Luther King, Jr. Multi-Service Ambulatory Care Center Replacement Project and master plan for the campus, as outlined in the August 18, 2009 CEO board letter.
