**March 24, 2015**

**Evaluation of Potential Conversion of Public Housing Units to the RAD Program**

The Annual Plan for Fiscal Year 2015-2016 of the Housing Authority of the County of Los Angeles (HACoLA) includes language regarding the potential disposition of 241 public housing units and the conversion of 168 units under the Rental Assistance Demonstration (RAD) Program.

RAD is a United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) initiative to preserve and improve public housing properties. On December 17, 2013, the Board of Supervisor's authorized the HACoLA to submit an application to HUD to participate in the RAD Program.

It is important that the HACoLA carefully weigh the pros and cons of the disposition and conversion to the RAD Program of any of its public housing units. It is also critical that the public housing residents are fully informed about the process and given the opportunity ask questions and express concerns.

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**I THEREFORE MOVE THAT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, ACTING AS

ANGELES:**

1. Instruct the Executive Director to report back to the Board of Supervisors (Board) in writing within 45 days on the pros and cons of submitting an application to the United States Housing and Urban Development Department (HUD) for the disposition of 241 public housing units and the conversion of 168 units to Rental Assistance Demonstration (RAD) Program. The report should also provide context as to the need for this hybrid strategy in public housing located in the Second District.
2. Instruct the Executive Director to ensure that additional meetings are held with the residents regarding the potential disposition and conversion of public housing units, and include the comments and feedback in the report back to the Board.
3. Instruct the Executive Director to return to the Board for approval of any disposition application prior to submittal to HUD.
