Vision: *To support the continuation and expansion of a catalytic and customer-oriented transit system that is safe, sustainable and well-connected.*

Principle 1: Riders Rule

- Creating meaningful opportunities for civic participation
- Streamlining subsidies for low-income riders



Principle 2: Building a System for Tomorrow

- Promoting the construction of a multi-modal transit network
- Advocating for investments that are regional, rational and equitable
- Facilitating long-term financial integrity for the agency, including pursuing new funding strategies to ensure Metro’s ability to deliver an updated Long Range Transportation Plan

- Ensuring that projects meaningfully engage local workers and small targeted businesses
- Pursuing catalytic joint development opportunities on Metro Property
- Exploring other opportunities for public-private partnerships
