**Request to Hear Item on an Urgency Basis Related to Funding of Health Facilities**

The Department of Health Services (DHS) learned from the Center for Medicare and Medicaid (CMS) that CMS has revised its processes and is requiring the State of California, with the County's assistance, to submit no later than October 30, 2015, a revised State Plan Amendment (SPA) related to funding for non-County facilities affected by the closure in 2007 of the County's Martin Luther King Jr. Medical Center. This action is needed because the SPA will commit the County to making three annual Intergovernmental Transfers of up to \$4.2 million each, the details of which are set out in the accompanying motion. Because this Board will not meet again prior to the need for DHS to take these actions, it must hear this item and take action today.

**WE THEREFORE MOVE THAT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, PURSUANT  
TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 54954.2(b)(2), FIND THAT:**

1. There is a need to take immediate action to authorize the Los Angeles County Department of Health Services to transfer up to \$4.2 million in
