### **EARVIN “MAGIC” JOHNSON PARK MASTER PLAN: PHASE I IMPLEMENTATION YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PLAN**

#### **BACKGROUND**

The proposed Phase I Implementation Project (Project) will include redesigning up to 11 acres of the park to include a new 20,000 square foot community events center, a 1,000-seat amphitheater, wedding pavilion, children’s play areas, splash pad, drought tolerant landscaping, other low-impact design features, and related improvements.

#### **Tasks that may be performed by At-Risk Youth**

Due to the technical nature and expertise required for design and other predevelopment activities, youth labor will not be utilized for the Project. This Project is part of a large multi-phase project and it is likely that youth labor will be utilized in future phases.

#### **Estimated cost of Youth Employment**

Not applicable. No youth will be employed for this project.

#### **Method of Youth Employment**

#### **Youth Employment Goal**

Under the provisions of the Los Angeles County Regional Park and Open Space District’s policy on employment of youth, the Youth Employment Minimum Obligation for the County of Los Angeles of \$15,739,750 has been met. However, the Department actively pursues employment opportunities for at-risk youth on all projects where feasible.
