**Revise Resolution for Acceptance of Additional Grant Funds for Various Improvements at Ladera Park**

The State of California Department of Housing and Community Development Housing-Related Parks (HRP) Program was designed to encourage cities and counties to develop new residential housing by awarding funds for park and recreational improvements to jurisdictions that make housing affordable to lower-income households.

On March 21, 2017, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors (Board) approved a resolution authorizing the Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) to submit a grant application and accept grant funds from the HRP Program for playground resurfacing and various park improvements at Ladera Park (the Project), located at 6027 Ladera Park Avenue in Los Angeles. The resolution approved by the Board specified that DPR could accept an amount not to exceed \$299,000. However, DPR was awarded an additional \$14,725 bonus funds for the Project, for a total grant award of \$313,725. Therefore, the Board must approve a revised resolution to accept the additional grant funds.
