WHEN: Wednesday, April 4, 2018 – 4:01 p.m.

WHAT: To commemorate the 50th anniversary of the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., several places of worship, schools and other institutions across the world will take part in the MLK50 Bell Toll.

Each will ring their bells 39 times, signifying the number of years that the civil rights leader lived. In Los Angeles, the bells will toll starting at exactly 4:01 p.m. PST, the moment that Dr. King died.
