



Do You Need a Flu Vaccine?

The LA County Department of Public Health is offering flu vaccines at no charge to people who don't have health insurance or whose healthcare provider does not offer flu vaccines.

Flu vaccines are recommended for everyone six months of age and older, including healthy adults. It's especially important to get a flu vaccine if you are:

- 6 months through 18 years old
- 50 years or older
- Pregnant or just had a baby
- Morbidly obese
- A health care provider
- Living in a nursing or other long-term care home
- Living with a weakened immune system or a chronic medical condition (like diabetes, heart disease or lung disease)
- Living with or caring for someone
 - > Under 5 years old
 - > 50 years of age or older
 - > With a chronic medical condition
