

**Seamless Child Care Delivery System**

The current CalWORKs Child Care Program is intended to provide a seamless child care delivery system among the various stages of child care. On January 6, 2012, the Center for Community and Family Services (CCFS), one of the 13 contracted Alternate Payment Provider agencies, relinquished its Resource and Referral and CalWORKs Stages 2 and 3 Child Care Program contracts to the California Department of Education. As the California Department of Education has redistributed CCFS's Stages 2 and 3 caseload, and to ensure a continued seamless delivery system and no interruption of services for families receiving Stage 1 Child Care services, it is vital that the Stage 1 caseload be redistributed according to the California Department of Education's realignment of CCFS's child care service area.

**I THEREFORE MOVE THAT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:**

- 1) Delegate authority to the Department of Public Social Services to terminate for convenience its CalWORKs Stage 1 Child Care contract with the Center for Community and Family Services, as soon as administratively possible;

- 2) Delegate authority to the Acting Director of Public Social Services to amend the CalWORKs Stage 1 Child Care Contracts, as soon as administratively possible, with the appropriate Alternative Payment Program agencies receiving CCFS's Stage 2 and 3 caseloads to receive CCFS's Stage 1 Child Care caseload, and increase contract budget amounts, as necessary to accommodate the resulting increased caseload; and
- 3) Instruct the Acting Director of DPSS, in collaboration with the Chief Executive Officer, to take any action which is necessary to exercise the delegated authority provided by this motion.
