- 4. Analyze and assess the County’s existing restitution collection program to determine (a) the practices and restitution rate of all property offenses (felony and misdemeanor) from November 2013 to the present and (b) the practices and restitution rate of only felony property offenses since November 2014;
- 5. Analyze and assess promising practices and strategies relevant to restitution collection programs, including but not limited to: installment payment plans; Victim-Offender Mediation programs that incorporate a restorative conflict resolution process; financial screening to assess each individual's ability; converting restitution orders to community service; and other restorative responses to restitution;
